Following the overwhelming positive feedback and demand from participants of the previous workshop, Vil-laju! Brunei proudly announces the successful completion of Projek Upskilling Tutong 2.0. The event took place at Dewan Serbaguna Serembangun Tutong on 2nd & 3rd March 2024.

The event is part of the BIBD Sustainability Youth Leadership Award, with Vil-Laju! Brunei being recognized as award recipients in the Job Cluster. The group utilized the project grant awarded to them for organizing this event. The event is also in accordance to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) #8 Decent Work and Economic Growth, #9 Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure, #10 Reduced Inequalities and #12 Responsible Consumption and Production. In addition, this event relates the second principle of UN SDG: Leave no one behind (LNOB).
